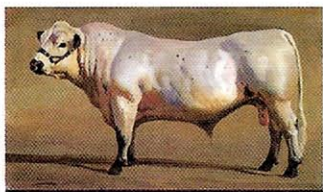


# ART TODAY: BEST OF BRITISH

**British White Bull**

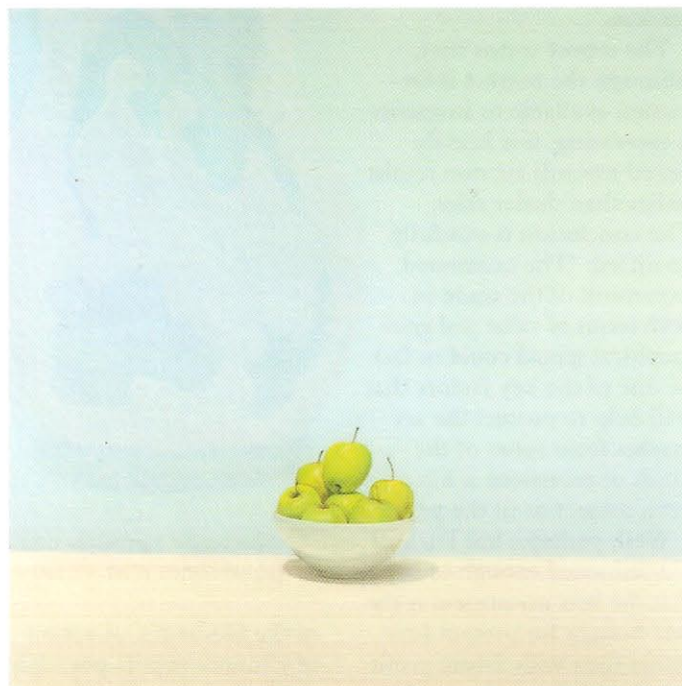
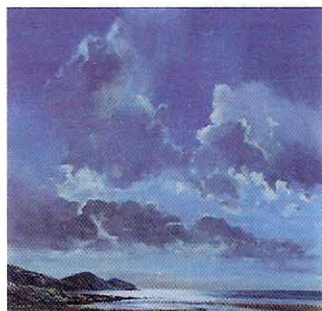
Duncan Palmar, a painter of spectacularly expansive views of sea and sky, his distinctive style captures texture, light and atmosphere.

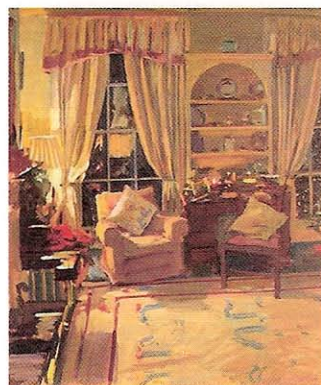

**L'Essence de la beauté**



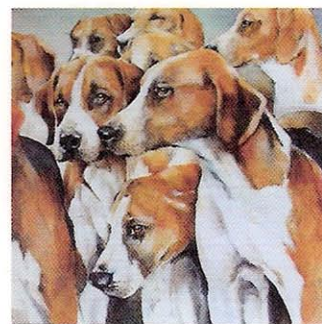
Charles Simpson is one of the most important landscape painters working in Scotland today. He draws his inspiration from the Scottish North-West to the rugged coastline of Cornwall.
